### What is Impact investing?

GIIN: "Impact investments are investments made with the intention to generate positive, measurable social and environmental impact alongside a financial return."

CFA/PRI/GSIA: "Investing with the intention to generate a positive, measurable social and/or environmental impact alongside a financial return."

Impact Investing Institute: "The practice of deploying capital so it can achieve specific positive environmental or social impacts as well as a financial return for investors."



#### **Timeline**

1960s: 'socially responsible investing' emerges

Ford Foundation pioneers 'program-related investments'

2000s: impact investing emerges

The term 'impact investing' is coined by the Rockefeller Foundation









1990s: sustainable investing emerges 2021: US\$1.16 trillion in impact investing worldwide



How would you rank YOUR INSTITUTION'S interest in impact investing in private markets?








